

PRE-REQUISITES FOR DIVE MASTER COURSE

1. Current SAA membership.
2. Hold a dive supervisor grade.
3. Hold a diver rescue award.
4. Be a qualified boat handler.
5. Hold a current SAA medical certificate.
6. Minimum of five years diving experience.
7. Logged at least 100 dives in varying conditions and locations.
8. Be a marine VHF radio license holder.

All applications are to be made on a SAA national application form and accompanied by a dive master assessment form. On completion, both forms should be sent to the national diving officer, accompanied by the candidate's qualification book and dive log book. Courses are held once a year normally in September.

Completed applications for the course must be received prior to the SAA AGM (Normally in March)

Part 1 of the course will take the form of a written exam which will be set for June or July of that year. Candidates who successfully pass the exam will then progress onto part 2.

Part 2 of the course will consist of a two day assessment of Diving skills, boat handling skills and organization skills.
